

Se esiste quindi un rapporto di memoria e di scoperta che lega i luoghi delle proprie origini alle citta' del presente e del futuro, allora credo sia proprio la possibilita' di questa sovrapposizione il cuore della domanda che un Istituto Italiano di Cultura pone alla citta' che lo ospita e a cui, con la propria attivita', cerca di dare una risposta.

Mi sembra quindi quantomai significativo ospitare questi due artisti italiani e le loro opere nella cornice della nostra sede di Londra, come a voler ribadire, a noi stessi, al pubblico e a questa multiforme metropoli, che la risposta per una diversa e piu' ricca esperienza della realta' urbana va cercata in cio' che non e' familiare, immediato, conosciuto. Ringrazio quindi Lisa e Massimo per offrirci un'ulteriore occasione per contribuire, attraverso la loro arte, a questo importante confronto. In Lisa Borgiani and Massimo Nidini's photo paintings, which have been collected especially in this aptly named exhibition Dynamic Cities, I have noticed an interesting approach which brings together, across time and space, very different urban landscapes, and through them, different cultures. This closeness, be it only dreamt of or hoped for, is actually made possible by the creative joint effort of two artists and their photographic and pictorial language.

Cologne and Verona, Trieste and Singapore, Paris-Venice-New York, a superimposition of metropolis and art cities: a metamorphosis where the modern momentum of the former and the historical depth of the latter complement each other. Buildings, big crossroads, bridges and other impenetrable and imposing urban signs, reshaped with colourful warmth and humanity by communicating with what is distant, beyond any geographical temporal and cultural boundary.

Every single city provokes sensations and triggers different questions in its visitors; in the same way the traveller recognizes and remembers what is his, only by exploring the unknown. If such a relationship of reminiscence and di-discovery exists and ties our places of origin to present and future cities, I believe the chance of such coexistence to be the core question an Italian Cultural Institute must ask to the city that hosts it, since cultural activity is an attempt to find an answer.

Therefore, it is ever so meaningful to host these two Italian artists and their works in the setting of our Institute in London, as to restate to ourselves, to the public and to this protean metropolis that the answer for a different and richer experience of urban reality has to be found in what is unfamiliar, distant and still unknown. I therefore renew my thanks to Lisa and Massimo for letting us further contribute, through their art, to this cultural challenge.

Last but not least, many thanks to Flavio Tosi, Mayor of Verona, for his support and to the Banco Popolare of Verona for making this exhibition possible.


